Map Verification

Aberdeen City Council is using **Modern** aerial imagery in a wide range of applications within the authority. The main use of the imagery is in the verification of its base mapping. The GIS team compares features found in aerial mapping that are often missing in mapping to enhance and confirm map content. **Modern** aerial imagery has been used while preparing the Corporate Address Gazetteer to identify the accuracy of postal addresses against building location.

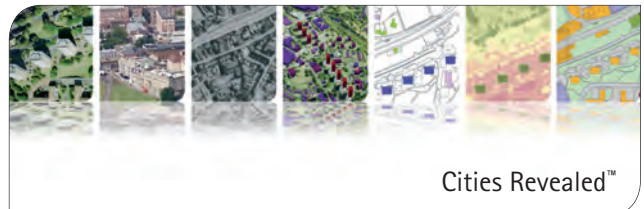
